FILING A FLOAT PLAN WITH THE PORT CAPTAIN WHEN EVER YOUR SLIP IS VACANT FOR MORE THAN **48** HOURS ENABLES DRYC TO OFFER SLIP ACCOMMODATIONS TO MEMBERS OF VISITING YACHT CLUBS.
