REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. No person shall live aboard a vessel <u>in excess of three days in any one week period</u> within Marina del Rey without first obtaining a permit from the Harbor Master.
- 2. Permits are valid for a period of one year commencing with the first day of the month following the month of issuance and shall be renewed on each successive annual anniversary. Persons living aboard for more than three days in anyone week period without a valid permits are in violation of the Los Angeles County Code and may be cited and/or subject to ejectment. INITIAL _____
- 3. A violation of any regulation duly promulgated by the Harbor Master or Director of the Department of Beaches and Harbors regarding vessels used as abodes, or any other regulations necessary to insure the maintenance of sanitary and sightly conditions and the preservation and protection of the public health, safety, peace, welfare, and convenience of the Marina shall be cause for revocation for the use of any vessel, floating home, houseboat, or floating facility as an abode. It shall then be unlawful for any person to live aboard such vessel, houseboat, or floating facility until such violation has been corrected to the satisfaction of the Harbor Master and/or the Director of the Department of Beaches and Harbors.

- 4. Permits are issued at no charge from the Harbor Master's Office after the vessel has been inspected by the Harbor Patrol. Items to be inspected are set forth in paragraph 6. Appointments may be made by calling (310) 823-7762.

5. Agreements regarding the terms and conditions of slip tenancy, including the rent payable, the duration of any slip agreement, and the uses to which areas may be put, are the subject of negotiation between the slip tenant and the lessee (marina operator). Issuance of a permit does not constitute approval, disapproval, or participation in such rental agreement by the Harbor Master or County. A permit from the Harbor Master is intended merely as a means of ensuring compliance with seaworthiness and sanitation requirements contained in the County Code. A permit does not grant to a tenant any interest in land or water. Nothing in the permit procedure shall be construed to give rise to a landlord-tenant relationship between the Harbor Master and slip tenants.

- 6. Inspection of the following items is generally made; however, circumstances or vessel design may cause variation:
 - a) A vessel must befit and safe for travel on the waters of California under its own sailing or mechanical propulsion system.
 - b) Vessels must meet all applicable State and Federal regulations pertaining to the class and size of vessel in question (see attached).
 - c) Vessels must be equipped with a Marine Sanitation Device (MSD) meeting current Federal requirements. Approved fixtures are those which preclude or prevent the discharge of effluent into the waters of the Marina, Vessels with systems equipped with by-pass valves for pumping at sea may be required to have the valve sealed while in the Marina.
- 7. The Liveaboard Permit shall be affixed to the vessel's transom or a rear facing window with the numbers denoting the month of expiration to the left and the year of expiration to the right, and must remain visible at all times.

INITIAL

The undersigned agrees to abide by all rules and regulations of the Harbor Master, the lessee (marina operator, or the County of Los Angeles and understands a violation of the provisions of this permit or any other applicable ordinance shall he cause for revocation of this permit. If an MSD is required to be sealed by the Harbor Master, the undersigned further agrees to allow periodic inspection of said seal.

Applicant's Signature

As the authorized agent of this anchorage, the applicant has been approved for liveaboard status, pending approval of results of this inspection.

Dockmaster's Signature

The vessel described above was inspected on this date and found to be in seaworthy condition as defined in the Los Angeles County Code, and met all requirements for a Liveaboard Permit.
